Marriage & Relationships With Biblical Foundation

- Pray for your husband daily—his leadership, faith, and work
- Encourage and uplift your husband with words that affirm his role
- Respect and honor him as the spiritual leader of your home.
- Forgive quickly—love keeps no record of wrongs (1 Corinthians 13:5)
- Read the Bible and Pray Together, and grow spiritually as a couple.
- Serve each other selflessly—marriage is about giving, not just receiving.
- Have Christ-centered date nights—talk about what God is doing in your lives.
- Speak his love language—acts of service, words, gifts, time, or touch.
- Set an example of faith—be the kind of wife that draws him closer to Christ.
- Keep your marriage private—seek Godly counsel, but avoid gossiping about your spouse

Motherhood with a Kingdom Perspective

- Dedicate your children to the Lord and pray over them daily.
- Take them to church and get them involved in the church. A Bible-based church that stands on the true meaning of God's Word.
- Live out your faith—your kids learn more from your actions than your words. They are watching everything you do! They are a product of what you do!
- Apologize if you are wrong and remember you and they are not perfect. Give them the Grace that God gives us daily.
- Encourage their faith by sharing testimonies of God's goodness.
- Help them develop a prayer life—teach them to pray about everything.
- Guard their hearts and minds from negative influences such as some television shows, movies, places and music.
- Lead family devotionals—even short ones make an impact - try reading one before school or in the carpool line
- Teach them to serve—get involved in church and community projects together.
- Trust God with their future—they belong to Him first.

Home Management with Biblical Principles

- Create a home filled with God's peace—pray over your home.
- Anoint your home with anointing oil: doors, walls, door posts, windows, rooms and etc.
- Play worship music to create a joyful atmosphere.

- Establish routines to keep order and reduce stress.
- Teach your children responsibility by involving them in chores.
- Prepare meals with love and gratitude for God's provision.
- Practice hospitality—open your home for fellowship.
- Let go of perfectionism—God cares more about your heart than a spotless house.
